What is a Medicare SELECT Plan?

A Medicare SELECT plan is a standard Medicare Supplement Plan with a "Network" of health care facilities. A Network means a hospital or provider that has an agreement with Sanford Health Plan and has been designated to provide services for this product.

What Network facilities must I use if I become a Sanford SELECT Member?

Except in an emergency, your coverage includes the Network of participating Sanford SELECT hospitals or outpatient surgery centers.

Who can join the Sanford SELECT Plan?

Anyone who has Medicare Parts A and B can apply for coverage with the Sanford SELECT Plan. You must physically live in one of these Iowa counties to join the

SELECT Plan: Clay, Dickinson, Emmet, Lyon, O'Brien, Osceola & Sioux.

What coverage do I have when traveling outside the Sanford SELECT service area?

You are always covered for emergency and urgent care services while traveling outside of the Sanford SELECT service area.

If I join the Sanford SELECT Plan, can I continue to see my doctor?

Yes, there are no Network requirements on doctors or clinics, including specialists. However, if you need to be hospitalized, your doctor will need to have admitting privileges at a Network hospital or surgical center.
