Description: The facility, as the name describes, is the shape of a Pentagon. There are total of 9 courts (six high school regulation, 2 professional/college practice courts, and the “Heritage” court). Floor space can be transitioned to accommodate 11 volleyball courts and is set up nicely for wrestling or Cheer/Dance Events. The Heritage Court is a premium professional/college size court. The design inspiration of the Heritage court is reminiscent of 1950’s/1960’s basketball that is supported with: state of art audio-visual scoreboards, executive suites, fantastic food options, handicap accessibility, vending, and retail shopping.

Description: At Sanford POWER we provide access to comprehensive functional, physiological and biomechanical evaluations, as well as rehabilitation and nutritional consultation services. POWER programs are for anyone who is looking to improve his/her physical performance, or to identify risk and work to prevent musculoskeletal injuries. This facility will also be the home of the National Youth Sports Health & Safety Institute under the direction of Michael F. Bergeron PhD, FACSM. The institute is a partnership between Sanford Health and the American College of Sports Medicine (the largest sports medicine advisory council in the world with over 20,000 members). The POWER program is an important component of the integrated services provided by Sanford Orthopedics & Sports Medicine.

Investment: \$8 million

When will the Fieldhouse be open? Fall 2012

In November 2011, we announced the sale of POWER Center facility located at 69th and Cliff to the University of Sioux Falls. This announcement was the beginning of the timeline for the development of the Sanford Sports Complex. We are pleased to announce that we are on schedule with this ambitious schedule and look forward to opening the Fieldhouse in August of this year. The new Sanford POWER Center (Fieldhouse) will also allow for further integration of sports medicine, sports physical therapy, elite athletic performance services and youth sports research activities by combining them into one venue. This project underscores that Sanford is the leader in providing the very best programs, services and facilities that promote safe youth sports participation.
