Julie Loveland Swanstrom, Ph.D.

Julie Loveland Swanstrom is an associate professor of philosophy, religion, and environmental studies at Augustana University in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. She teaches philosophy, religion, ethics, and environmental culture courses, and her work often intersects with early science, medicine, and technology. In her research, she explores medieval theories of causation and also applies medieval philosophy and theology to popular culture media. She volunteers to promote religious awareness and support through South Dakota Faith in Public Life and encourages public engagement with water quality and use as Area 7 Director of the East Dakota Water Development District.



David O'Hara, Ph.D.

Dr. David O'Hara is Professor of Philosophy, Religion, and Environmental Studies; Religion Department Chair; Director of Environmental Studies and Sustainability; and Clara Lea Olson Professor of Christian Values at Augustana University. His research and teaching concern the history of ideas, technology for human flourishing, interreligious studies, semiotics, and environmental sustainability. He is the Founder and Director of Ktema, LLC, which fosters perennial ideas that sustain and connect us to one another.
