




Preventive screenings and laboratory tests


Your executive health assessment may include the following:

Tests and screenings

- Genetic screening with a genetic counselor
- Heart screening, including EKG and heart score CT
- Integrative health consult
- Mammogram (women age 40 and older)
- Nutritional consult
- Pap test (women age 21 and older)
- Prostate screening (men age 50 and older)
- Thorough skin check
- Vascular screening, including ultrasounds
- Wellness and stress management consult

Labs

- Blood glucose test
- Cholesterol panel, including apolipoprotein B and lipoprotein (a)
- Complete blood count and electrolyte panel
- Iron studies
- Kidney function test
- Liver panel
- Thyroid function test
- Vitamin D, B12 and folate levels



To ensure seamless delivery of care, it is recommended that appointments be scheduled at least three to four weeks in advance.

If you are not currently enrolled in My Sanford Chart, we encourage you to sign up. We can assist you with this process. There is no cost to enroll, and it provides access to some of your lab results and testing information in real time, allowing you to review the details and prepare any questions you may have in advance.

Once your appointment is scheduled, you will receive two confirmation messages via My Sanford Chart with details about your appointment. These messages will include explanations of any testing or procedures, as well as answers to frequently asked questions. The first message will be sent approximately one month prior to your visit, and the second about one week before.

To help the physician and care team plan your schedule for the day, we recommend you fill out the lifestyle, personal health history and family history questionnaires on My Sanford Chart.
