Our Approach To Care


We bring together recognized maternal-fetal medicine specialists and pediatric sub-specialties to deliver leading technologies, integrated support services and the best care. We work closely with each patient's referring physician and welcome involvement at every step.

Each patient who visits us receives a comprehensive diagnostic evaluation, which may include prenatal ultrasound, fetal echocardiogram and a fetal MRI along with diagnosis-specific subspecialty consultation. Once this evaluation has been completed, an interdisciplinary team of experts meets to review every aspect of the evaluation and prepare recommendations for a plan of care.

The maternal-fetal care team will review the fetal imaging findings with the patient and her family to explain the implications and the team's recommendations for a plan of care. Our recommendations may include prenatal management, the potential role of fetal intervention, suggested delivery management, postnatal treatment and long-term implications of diagnosis.

The RN coordinator arranged time for us to meet with our doctor to discuss the surgery, meet another doctor from the NICU and tour the NICU – all before our baby was even born!

State-of-the-art, Medical Campus



We can diagnose and care for a number of conditions through the latest treatments and procedures. Our fetal surgery team includes pediatric surgeons, maternal-fetal medicine specialists and several pediatric specialists determined to improve outcomes and enhance quality of life for every mother and baby we treat.

Referring A Patient

Whether you are a perinatologist, OB/GYN, certified nurse midwife or family medicine physician, when you refer a patient to Sanford Fetal Care Center, we consider you a part of our team. We partner with you to find the best care for your patient.

You are welcome to attend each and every meeting, and we'll work closely with you to ensure you are involved in every step. Our team will send the comprehensive consultation letter that summarizes our findings and will forward any important notes and follow-up care instructions. We are available by phone at any time to answer your questions.

At the initial meeting, we review and recommend the appropriate approach for your patient during pregnancy through labor and delivery. Most often, we support patients remaining with their primary care provider for delivery; however, in specific high-risk pregnancies we will recommend your patient deliver at our facility.

If your patient has a preexisting condition where other specialists are involved in care, we welcome those specialists to work with us during pregnancy. We encourage patients to keep the providers they had prior to enrolling with us and welcome these providers to contact our coordinators any time with any questions or concerns

Our maternal-fetal medicine specialists are available for urgent referrals, consultations and transfers 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
