# **Getting Ready**

## MRI Biopsy/Enclosed Spaces

Talk to your regular doctor if you have a fear of enclosed spaces. You may choose to take a medicine to help you relax during the MRI biopsy. Bring the relaxation medicine with you.

## Arrange a Driver if Needed

Your doctor may require you to arrange a driver (refer to pink box).

Also, many women prefer a driver. You may want someone to drive you home if:

• You live out-of-town with a longer distance to drive.

## Eating and Drinking

You can eat and drink as usual before the biopsy.

#### A driver is required if:

- I plan to use a sedative during my MRI biopsy.
- The breast health department notified me that I need a driver.



# **Medicines**

## Changing Some Medicines Before Surgery

Some medicines and supplements need to be stopped or changed before a biopsy. Talk to the doctor who prescribed the following medicines to see if changes are needed. Write your instructions below.

- Blood thinners (such as warfarin or Plavix):
- NSAIDs (such as Advil or Aleve) or aspirin:
- Herbal medicines or supplements:

You may take pain medicine that contains Tylenol (acetaminophen) during the time when you cannot use NSAIDs or aspirin as noted above.

# Day of the Biopsy

#### What to Wear

Wear loose, comfortable clothing:

- Separate shirt and pants.
- A top that is easy to take off and put on.
- A supportive bra without underwire such as a sports bra. The bra will be worn after the biopsy to hold the bandages and ice packs in place and to support the breast.

# After Your Biopsy

## Taking Care of Yourself

Your doctor will tell you how to take care of yourself after your biopsy. Follow your doctor's instructions about:

- Taking it easy the rest of the day. You may not want to return to work.
- Using an ice pack in your bra for about 24 hours.
- Taking acetaminophen (Tylenol) for pain after the biopsy.



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
