Children 0-19 years of age account for more than half of the total poison exposures reported to poison centers in 2020.

Everyday **many** children are seen in the emergency room because of being exposed to harmful products. Some of these products include, but not limited to:

- Cleaning supplies
- Personal care products
- Medicine

- Pesticides
- Alcohol
- Laundry products

Laundry Beads are a risk to children as they look like other foods. Children often mistake the beads for candy or other foods if they are stored in containers different than the original packaging.
