



Dear Prospective Resident,

I am excited to share about our Postgraduate Year Two (PGY-2) Clinical Pharmacogenomics Residency at Sanford Imagenetics. We are actively recruiting for our first resident for the 2021-2022 residency year.

Sanford Imagenetics serves a large rural population with 45 hospitals and 289 clinics in nine states. Sanford Imagenetics has received ASHP pre-candidate status for a PGY-2 Clinical Pharmacogenomics Residency beginning 2021 and will follow the ASHP Residency Learning System. Our program is designed to provide structure and development of personal and professional goals that will provide a successful residency experience. A research project will be completed during the 12 month residency.

The resident will have opportunities to teach pharmacy students from several Colleges of Pharmacy as well as precept PGY-1 residents completing a pharmacogenomics elective.

Residents will be provided health insurance, dental insurance, life insurance, and 20 days of paid time off (includes sick days). The stipend is competitive and updated annually. Residents will receive expense coverage to attend ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting plus the Midwest Pharmacy Residents Conference to present their research project.

Applications are due through the ASHP Resident Matching Program by January 5<sup>th</sup>. Due to the current pandemic, interviews will be conducted virtually for 2021.
