POINTS FOR PARENTS TO REMEMBER:

- Keep a watchful eye accidents happen quickly.
- Consider having one safe cabinet where your child can explore and fill cabinet with unbreakable items.

SAFE KITCHEN CHECKLIST

The Stove

- ☐ Turn pot and pan handles towards the back of the stove. ☐ Teach your baby what "HOT" means and to stay away
- from the stove and oven.

Small Appliances

- ☐ Toddlers can pull cords and risk electrocution. Keep small appliances unplugged and cords out of reach.
- ☐ Install a dishwasher lock to prevent child access to breakable dishes, knives, and other dangerous objects

The Trash

- ☐ Keep a lid on trash can and keep in a locked cabinet.
- ☐ Keep trash and plastic grocery bags out of reach. These are one of the most dangerous items in your home.

General

- Matches and lighters are stored in a locked cabinet.
- Cabinet under the sink is free of cleaning supplies, bug sprays, dishwasher detergent, and dishwashing liquids.
- Knives, forks, scissors, and other sharp tools in a drawer with a childproof latch.
- ☐ Glass objects out of reach.
- Sandwich bags are stored in a locked cabinet.
- ☐ Have a working fire extinguisher.
- ☐ Highchair has a safety belt with a strap between legs.
- ☐ Keep refrigerator magnets and small objects out of reach.
