

GRADING SCALES

Students must achieve at least a 78% (C) in each didactic course and for every Clinical Grade in order to continue in the program. Any student who receives a final course grade of less than 78% will be dismissed from the program. There is NO option for appeal. Courses cannot be repeated.

1. For all Clinical and Didactic coursework:

94 - 100% = A 86 - 93% = B

78 - 85% = C

Below 78% is failing

2. For LAB:

98 - 100% = A

94 - 97% = B

90 - 93% = C

Below 90% is failing

Completed didactic courses, and Clinical and LAB Grades will be given upon the completion of each semester during student conferences. Didactic averages will be given for courses not completed at that time. Conferences will be held upon completion of each semester.

1st semester (Clinical Education I) - end of January

2nd semester (Clinical Education II) - end of July

3rd semester (Clinical Education III) - end of January
