

Sanford Radiography Program Effectiveness Data

ARRT Pass Rate – the number of graduates who pass the credentialing examination, given by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists, on first attempt; *JRCERT requires a five-year pass rate of not less than 75% on first attempt*

Program Completion Rate – the number of students who complete the program within 150% of the stated program length; 22-month program starts the first Monday in August annually, and ends the last Friday in May; the Sanford Bismarck Radiography Program has set a benchmark of 80% for completion rate annually

Job Placement Rate – the number of graduates employed in the field of Radiology compared to the number of graduates who actively sought employment; *JRCERT requires a five-year average job placement rate of not less than 75% within twelve months of graduation*

Graduate Satisfaction – Graduate satisfaction scores are determined by the results of an annual survey given to graduates, and their responses to this question: “How would you rate your overall satisfaction of this program?” number provided is an average of all surveys returned

Scoring for Graduate Satisfaction:

5 = Excellent; 4 = Above average; 3 = Average; 2 = Below average; 1 = Poor
