



Sanford Health 2019 Heart of Tomorrow Program

Sanford Health's Heart of Tomorrow program is designed to assist employees' dependent children with a \$1,000 gift to be used in their pursuit of post-secondary education.

Eligible applicants meet the following criteria:

- The applicant must be a high school senior or high school graduate planning to enroll or currently enrolled in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational-technical program of their choice.
- Cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or greater, calculated on a 4.0 grading scale.
- Dependent children (up to the age of 24) of full-time, part-time or unscheduled part-time employees of Sanford Health as of April 7, 2018.
- Employees of Sanford Health managed facilities are not eligible to apply.

Eligible students may apply online at www.sanfordhealth.org (search keyword: scholarship and expand the Heart of Tomorrow section). Applications are due on March 29, 2019.

Application Requirements

- An essay that demonstrates the student's service, scholarship humble leadership and impact (maximum 500 words).
- The applicant must send an official transcript of grades from their last completed semester of study from the current or most recently attended educational facility. The transcript should show a cumulative GPA and must be postmarked by April 7, 2019. Mail to:

Award Details

- The Heart of Tomorrow program is considered a gift to the employee and therefore the employee will incur the applicable payroll taxes on a future paycheck.
- Students may reapply each year they meet the qualifications.
- Employees with more than one qualifying dependent can submit multiple applications, but only one gift will be awarded per family, per year.
- Each applicant can only be awarded the Heart of Tomorrow twice during their post-secondary studies (\$2,000 lifetime award limit).
